Emirates NBD: Have all nods to buy RBL stake

Mumbai, 15 May

Emirates NBD on Friday said it has received all regulatory and governmental approvals, including clearance from the Government of India, for its proposed acquisition of a majority controlling stake in RBL Bank, paving the way for completion of one of the largest cross-border banking deals in India.

The proposed investment of around \$3 billion (₹26,850 crore), first announced in October 2025, marks the largest equity fund raise in the Indian banking sector and the first acquisition of a majority stake in a profitable Indian bank by a foreign banking institution, Emirates NBD said. Emirates NBD will subscribe to up to 959 million

equity shares of RBL Bank at ₹280 per share through a preferential allotment, giving it nearly 60 per cent of the lender's post-issue paid-up share capital. Its eventual holding is expected to range between 51 per cent and 74 per cent, subject to foreign ownership norms and completion of the mandatory open offer.

Emirates NBD said the approvals underline the growing economic and financial relationship between India and the UAE and reinforce India's position as a preferred destination for long-term foreign capital.

"Emirates NBD continues to accelerate development across our network and deepen our presence in high-potential regional markets like India," said Sheikh

Ahmed bin Saeed Al-Majum, chairman of Emirates NBD. "The successful accomplishment of this milestone acquisition underscores the strategic and long-standing relationship with the country."

Hesham Abdulla Al Qassim, vice-chairman and managing director of Emirates NBD, said the approval would enable the bank to begin integrating RBL Bank into the wider group and strengthen its ability to support India's growth with "capital capability and connectivity".

Group chief executive Stephen Nelson said the transaction positions Emirates NBD "at the centre of a critical trade, wealth and investment corridor" linking India and the Gulf region.

SC: Won't pass order in favour of Aravalli lease holders

The Supreme Court (SC) on Friday said it won't pass any order in favour of mining lease holders as it has been getting "quite disturbing" feedback on mining in the Aravalli hills and ranges.

"The apex court had there were specific ecological issues and in February it had asked the environment ministry and other stakeholders to suggest names of domain experts for a panel to define the Aravalli hills and ranges."

"We will not hear this matter in a piecemeal manner. We will not permit any activity unless we are fully satisfied," a bench of Chief Justice Surya Kant and Justice Jaymya Bagchi said on Friday.

IIC declares Bhojshala site a temple; Muslims to move SC

The Madhya Pradesh High Court declared the disputed Bhojshala-Kama Maula Mosque complex in Jabalpur district a temple. In its verdict delivered on Friday, the High Court concluded that the proceer site is a temple of Goddess Saraswati after considering all facts, as well as the survey report from the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI). Muslim party said they will challenge the decision in SC. A division bench quashed the High Court order that allowed Muslims to offer prayers at the site. The bench said, "The 2003 ASI order, which restricted the rights of Hindus to worship and permitted prayers by the Muslim community, is quashed."

SC urged to list contempt plea in GM crop case

The Supreme Court on Friday was urged to list for hearing a plea seeking contempt proceedings against top government officials alleging a "wilful and deliberate" violation of its orders on the release of genetically modified and gene-edited crops.


The contempt plea, filed by Aruna Rodrigues as part of her 2005 writ, on the issue, alleged that the government has not followed the July 25, 2024, judgement and various earlier orders of the apex court by which it was directed to first evolve a comprehensive national policy on genetically modified (GM) crops through a consultative process involving experts, state governments, and all stakeholders before releasing such crops.

SC allows remission of Madhumita murder convict

Observing that nature of an offence cannot be the sole ground for denying remission, the Supreme Court on Friday allowed a plea seeking premature release of one of the convicts in the 2003 murder case of 26-year-old poet Madhumita Shukla.

A bench of justices B.V. Nagarathna and Ujjal Bhuyan set aside the order of the Ministry of Home Affairs dated July 9, 2025, rejecting the Uttar Pradesh government's recommendation for premature release of convict Rohit Chaturvedi.

The top court noted that Chaturvedi has spent 23 years in jail without remission.

Unnau rape case: SC restores Kuldeep Sengar's jail sentence

The Supreme Court on Friday set aside a Delhi High Court order suspending the life sentence of former BJP MLA Kuldeep Singh Sengar in the 2017 Unnau rape case and asked it to decide the plea afresh.

A bench comprising Chief Justice of India (CJI) Surya Kant and Justice Jayalaxmi Bagchi also asked the high court to make endeavours to decide the main plea of Sengar against his conviction and life imprisonment in the case within two months.

It also said that if not possible for the high court to decide the main plea expeditiously, it should pass an order on a plea of Sengar seeking the suspension of his life term before the start of the summer vacation.

A bench of justices B V Nagarathna and Ujjal Bhuyan set aside the order of the Ministry of Home Affairs dated July 9, 2025, rejecting the Uttar Pradesh government's recommendation for premature release of convict Ronit Chaturvedi.

The top court noted that Chaturvedi has spent 22 years in jail without remission.
